## Senate Executive Committee Amendment to Bylaw 14.1

To: Academic Senate, Santa Cruz Division:

The Senate Executive Committee (SEC) proposes an amendment to Bylaw 14.1 to include membership of two additional committee chairs from the Committee on International Education (CIE) and Committee on Teaching (COT). Chairs for these two committees have received a standing invitation to attend all meetings for the last two years. Since the issue of on-line education emerged several years ago, SEC decided it was beneficial to have the voice of the COT at the table. Although that specific issue has lessened in urgency, the changing landscape of instructional delivery and student's changing engagement with instruction pushes the need to keep support for teaching prominent and the work of COT intersects with the purviews of several other committees. Likewise, with the campus's momentum around international enrollments and engagement, the CIE has added vital insight to these issues as they touched many other Senate committees. SEC is sensitive to the workload required of faculty doing Senate service and additional duties are not added lightly. SEC has experienced the value of these perspectives in our deliberations and since these issues are unlikely to decrease in importance, SEC proposes this bylaw change.
