Since its inception, the policy has struggled with the mix of academic issues and conduct issues, and how they should be resolved. It has always been clear that faculty are responsible for the grades in their course, and the administration is responsible for discipline, but what should happen when responsibility may be unclear, because the instructor is unsure, the case is not well documented, or there are excessive delays in reporting, in the college, or at the tribunal.

The new policy attempts to make this separation abundantly clear. No longer is the conduct process seeking to establish “responsibility”, which over time has turned into a spectrum of not responsible, responsible, and no finding. Instead, this clearly rests with the instructor, with the existing potential to appeal the final grade through the Senate’s grade grievance process.

The disciplinary process then determines whether the case rises to a disciplinary action. Typically a warning when there has been a violation of the Academic Conduct Policy on the first instance along with developmental sanctions, and potentially suspension and dismissal with multiple instances. If the documentation is insufficient or if a violation of class rules (such as leaving an exam room) is not coupled with evidence that cheating took place, there may be an admonishment, a contribution to the academic conduct record that does not carry a disciplinary action.
