Policy on Content of Summer Session Courses

A course taught during Summer Session must have the same content as when the same course is taught during the academic year, and conform to the course approval documentation that was approved by CEP or the Committee on Courses of Instruction, even if it is being offered in a compressed term¹.

If the instructor is new to the course, they should be provided with the course approval documentation (or syllabus) for the course.

The forms included in the request for Summer Session course proposals must include a check box for the course sponsoring unit to confirm that the content of the course is the same as during the academic year, and that if the instructor is new, they have been provided the necessary information about the content.
