Policy on Repeating Courses More Than Once

Santa Cruz Divisional Regulation SCR 9.1.8 requires a student to obtain the approval of their college before taking a course more than twice (i.e. repeating it more than once). Such a student petition must include the recommendation of the department before a decision is taken.

When deciding whether to permit a student to repeat a course more than once, colleges should consider the student's likelihood of passing the course, completing their major, or completing an alternative major. The departmental recommendations should be “weighted very heavily in making decisions”. However, the ultimate decision rests with the college.
