

UCSC Edward A. Dickson Emeritus Professorship Award
CALL FOR PROPOSALS

The Committee on Emeriti Relations (CER) is pleased to announce the call for proposals for the 2025-26 Edward A. Dickson Emeritus Professorship Award.

The Dickson Award supports the creative and innovative work that our faculty continue to do after retiring. The award may be used for activities in service, research (including creative works and performances), or teaching. Projects are expected to be completed within the 12-month grant period. Dickson Professors are expected to make the results of their work available to the campus or the wider community.

Applicants must have emeritus status at the time the proposal is submitted. Up to \$20,000 is available annually to support up to three proposals. Funds will be made available on July 1, to be expended within the academic year.

All applicants should consult the [Guidelines for the Dickson Award](#) before preparing their application. Applications include a [cover sheet](#), a 1-2 page proposal, and a 1 page budget. Letters of support are optional except in the circumstances detailed in the Guidelines.

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION: Monday, January 13, 2025.

Proposals, as well as letters of support, should be submitted by email to dickson.award-group@ucsc.edu. The name of the applicant and the nature of the document (*Proposal* or *Letter of Support*) should be provided in the subject header of the email message.
