

COMMITTEE ON THE LIBRARY AND SCHOLARLY COMMUNICATION CHARGE
 Proposed Amendments to Divisional Bylaw 13.24.1

To be consistent with recently revised UC Santa Cruz Librarians Association (LAUC-SC) bylaws, COLASC proposes the following change to the “sits-with” LAUC-SC appointees to the committee:

A portion of the relevant LAUC-SC bylaws change reads (LAUC-SC Bylaw Article IV, Section 4):

The [LAUC-SC] Chairperson shall...

10. Nominate or appoint the LAUC-SC representative to the UC Santa Cruz Committee on Libraries and Scholarly Communication for a term of one year, with the advice and consent of the Executive Board, no later than October 1.

11. Either represent LAUC-SC at COLASC meetings or appoint the Vice Chairperson to serve as the second LAUC-SC representative to COLASC.
